### **The Three-Legged Stool**

When leaders manage the 3 systems together.



### **The Weak Three-Legged Stool**

When leaders manage the systems as separate things.



### **The Broken Three-Legged Stool**

When leaders fail to manage an element, or sacrifice an element for the benefit of other elements

### When we ignore safety:

- It breaks due to lack of resources
  - Time
  - Money
  - Training
  - Supervision
  - Commitment

#### When we use shortcuts, or sacrifice safety:

- Your system breaks
- Trust is lost
- Requires massive resources to repair.

- SecTreas for Bush, Jr
- Chair International Paper, Rand, Blackstone
- Chair and CEO of Alcoa '87 to '99
  - Emphasized worker safety
  - Opposed by the board several "coup" attempts
  - Market value increased by a factor of 9
  - Net income increased by a factor of 7
