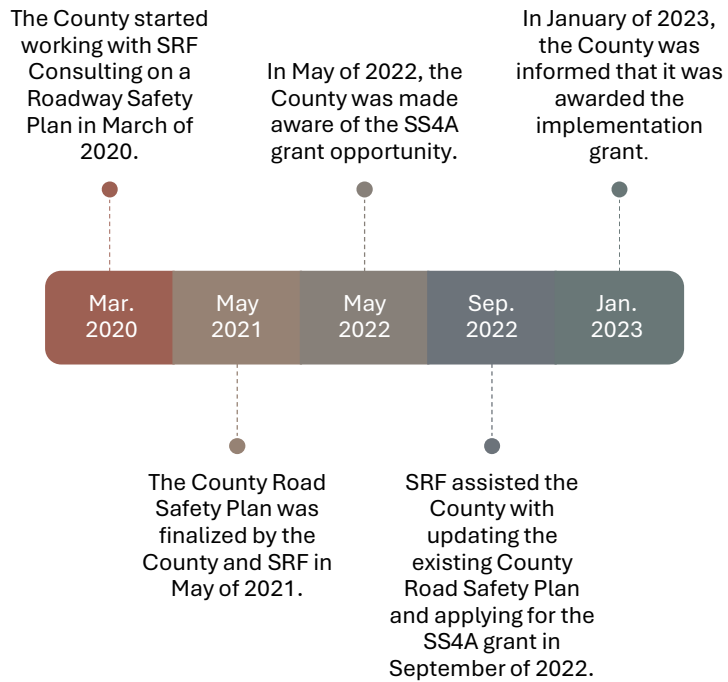
McKENZIE COUNTY

RECAP

- Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grants are to improve roadway safety by significantly reducing or eliminating roadway fatalities and serious injuries.
- Two types of grants:
 - Planning and Demonstration
 - Implementation
- McKenzie County was awarded a SS4A Implementation grant on January 31st, 2023.
 - The total project cost was \$3,573,244 with the SS4A Grant Funding amount being \$2,858,595.

 - 1 pedestrian/bicycle crash reduction locations

POST AWARD

- The grant agreement was executed in July of 2023.
- The County released an RFP for design services in September of 2024.
 - Ackerman-Estvold was selected as the consulting engineer for the project.
- Currently working through NEPA for the projects.
- Anticipate constructing some of the project in 2025.
